It is your civic duty to fill out the census once every ten years as mandated by the U.S. Constitution.

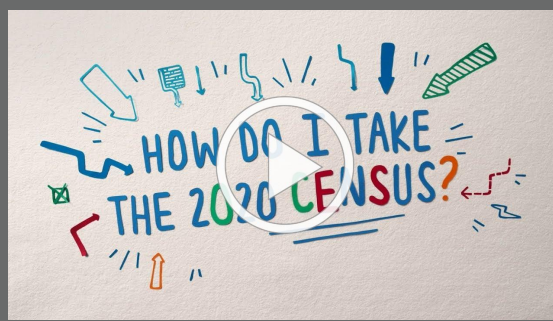
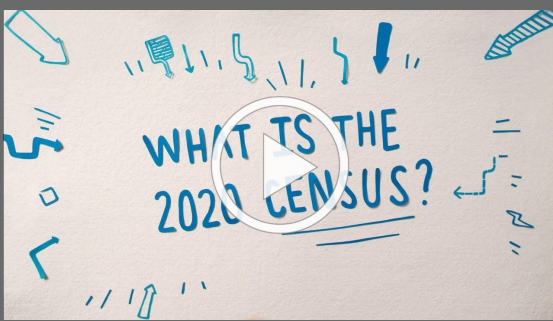
And, for the first time, you will be able to fill out the census online.

The Public Works Department is collaborating with the city of Miamisburg for potential savings in this year's street paving program. The following streets are scheduled to be paved in 2020:

- Washington Church Road from Spring Valley to Lyons
- Miami Village Drive from Lincolnshire to Austin Blvd.
- Benner Road from Byers to the city limit
- Small section of Shephard Road

The Board of Trustees passed a resolution approving the work at its February 25 meeting.

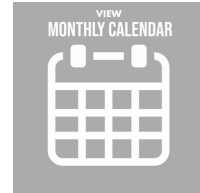


Video: Township pet wins Today Show's 'Best in Show'

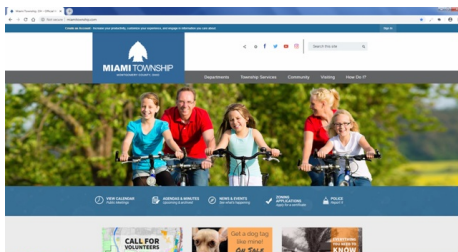
