Miami Township is once again selling 2021 dog licenses beginning December 1 through January 29, but due to the ongoing COVID pandemic, we urge residents to purchase 2021 dog licenses [ONLINE HERE](#).

Any in-person sales will be conducted at the Miami Township Police Department this year, 2660 Lyons Road, during regular business hours: Mondays from 7:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.; Tuesday-Friday, 7:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Please understand that in-person sales could change at any time depending on the issuance of further state COVID advisories. You may purchase a license online anytime!

Tags are \$20 (\$24 for unneutered pet) and there is a \$2 fee for online purchases. Tags purchased at the Miami Township Police Department are by CASH or CHECK only. Please make your check payable to *Miami Township*. If paying by cash, small bills are appreciated!

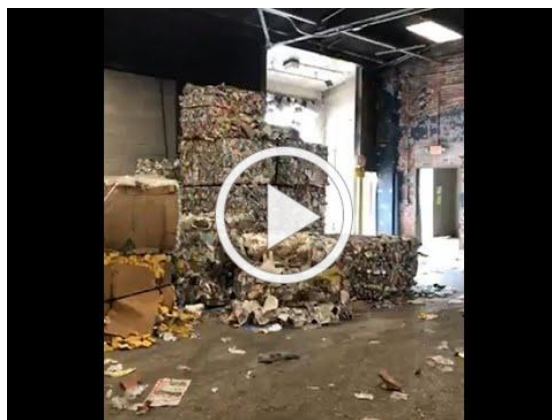
Road crews ready for winter

Holiday shopping safety



You need to be particularly cautious this time of year while out shopping. Always be aware of what's going on around you! Here are just a few safety tips to keep in mind during the holidays:

- Minimize shopping at night or alone
- Avoid carrying large amounts of cash
- Avoid the ATM; if you must use it, find one inside a well-populated, well-lit building; and protect your PIN from view
- Immediately report a lost or stolen credit card
- Keep only what you need for the day inside a wallet or purse
- Avoid carrying too many packages; they make you an easier target
- Avoid package theft by tracking your packages, have them delivered to your place of employment; install a security camera at home; require a signature upon delivery; ask your neighbors to grab packages while you're away

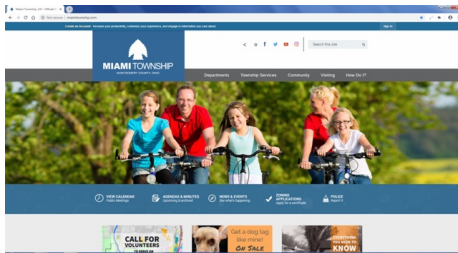
- Miami Township is now hiring for a full-time administrative assistant as well as full-time police officers. **CLICK** to apply

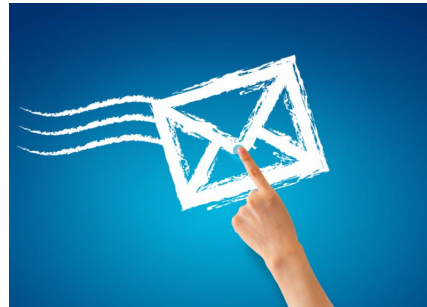
