Ken Snavelly loved a good party and Miami Township has been privileged over the years to be a part of the celebration. Most recently, we helped Ken celebrate his 105th birthday at a parade in his honor. Organized by his fellow veterans, Ken smiled from ear to ear with his family and friends by his side.

Ken died September 17, 2022, after a short illness, having lived out his final years at the Trinity Community of Miami Township. The World War II veteran served in the U. S. Army and later worked as a systems analyst for the Air Force Logistics Command. He is survived by two children, two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

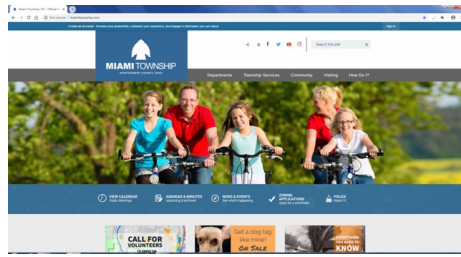
Did You Know?

- Early reminder: Fall leaf pickup begins November 1, 2022. Crews could start earlier if leaves fall sooner. [CLICK](#) for more.



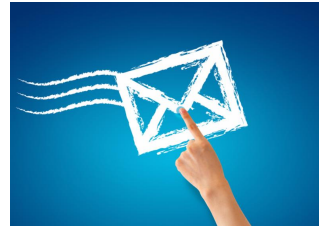
