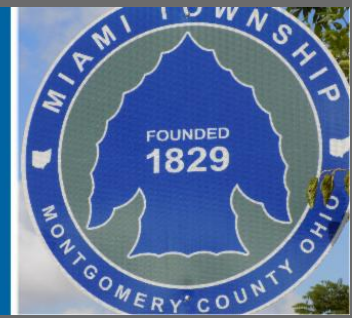

Gas/electric aggregation update

Applications and plans for Miami Township to be certified as an energy aggregator were forwarded to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) for consideration the week of June 13. It takes 30 days to receive a response. Following certification, our consultant, **Trebel Energy**, will begin to solicit bids for natural gas and electric generation rates on the township's behalf.

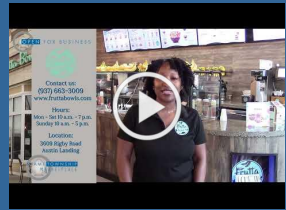

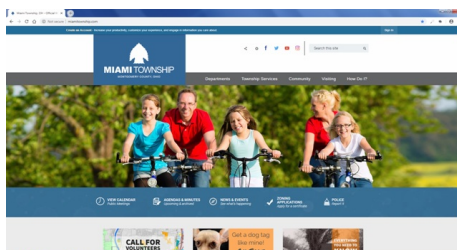
Did You Know?
