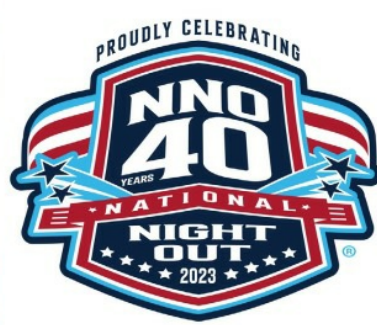
National Night Out

Ah, yes, Ohio weather. One minute, it is 90 degrees, 70 the next, but you can be certain that the heat is on this summer. The Centers for Disease Control says people 65 years and older, children under the age of 2, and those with chronic illness are at higher risk of heat-related illness.

While it may seem obvious, it is always a good idea to get a refresher course on simple ways to beat the heat:

- Drink plenty of water and pace yourself
- Stay in air-conditioned buildings as much as possible
- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing
- Plan outdoor activities earlier in the day or during evening hours

- Check on your friends and neighbors
- Never leave children and pets inside a hot car
- Check local news for health and weather update

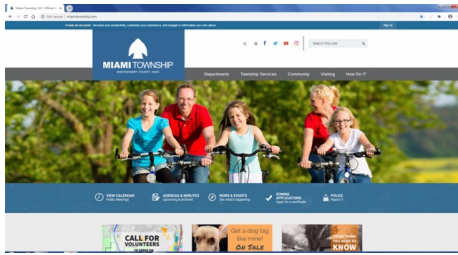
