Miami Township is selling dog licenses at the Government Center again this year. 2024 dog tags will be sold from December 1, 2023, through January 31, 2024, during regular business hours, M - F, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., at 2700 Lyons Road.

The cost is \$20 for a neutered pet, \$24 for an unneutered pet. If you do choose to visit the Government Center, we accept **EXACT CHANGE ONLY BY CASH OR BY CHECK.**

Rumpke trash service extended

The Miami Township Board of Trustees voted November 8, 2023, to extend the township's Rumpke Trash and Recycling contract, approving the first year of a two-year contract option. The township's current 3.5-year contract expires June 30, 2024.



By approving **Resolution #92-2023**, the township takes advantage of a 1-year extension, including a 4% cost increase. The new price, effective June 30, 2024, is \$15.24 per month, up from \$14.65 per month.

The Public Works Department reviewed comparison contracts and

discovered Miami Township's rate is still considerably less than other municipalities and does not include a fuel surcharge. For example, Brookville residents currently pay \$18.66 per month.

Cat-tastic program available

The Humane Society of Greater Dayton's Community Cat Initiative is wildly popular. The program performed 7,000 spay/neuters countywide this year and expects to perform 10,000 in 2024. There is currently a waiting list for the procedure.

Shelter staff recently shared information about the program during an informational session at the Dayton Metro Library **Miami Township branch**. Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) gives residents the opportunity to trap feral cats, have them neutered, then returned to the community. The Humane Society says TNR is the only proven way to successfully address the cat population.

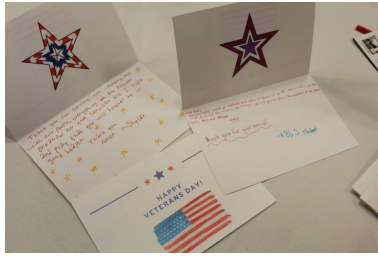

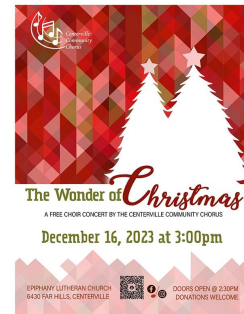
Skyline Santa arrives Dec. 2

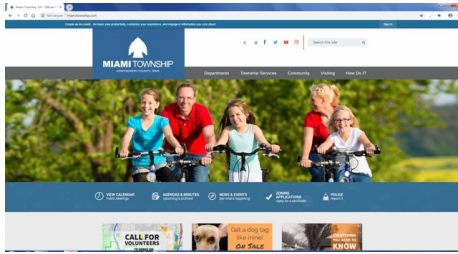

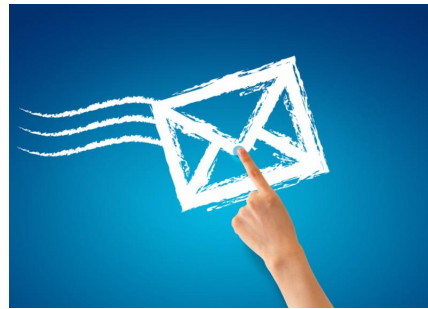
