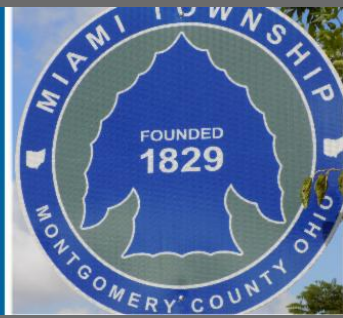

Active projects dot landscape

First Flight Commerce Center breaks ground



Multiple development projects dot the landscape in Miami Township

right now. One of the largest is well underway. Northpoint Development is clearing ground for the First Flight Commerce Center located east of the Dayton-Wright Brothers Airport on Austin Boulevard. Building 1 is a \$26 million, 264,268 square foot commitment. The business/industrial park is expected to attract 615 jobs to the region. An Italian transformer manufacturer is considering the future business park, as well as two others, for its first U.S. production company.

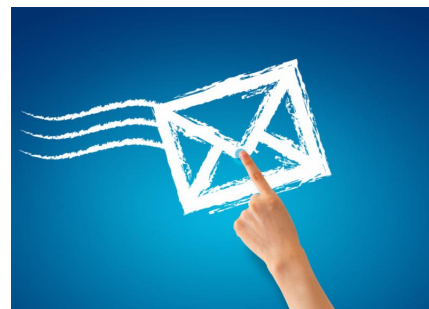
