Students from across Miami Township will be heading back to class in August. Teachers and staff typically start a few days before students to attend in-service days and prepare their classrooms.

The two largest districts serving township children are the Miamisburg City School District with just under 5,000 enrolled and the West Carrollton City Schools with more than 3,300 enrolled. Township students also attend Valley View and Carlisle public schools. Dayton Christian School and Bishop Liebold School have campuses located within our borders.

Welcome, Taste of Belgium

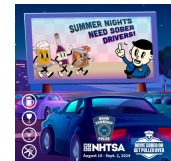

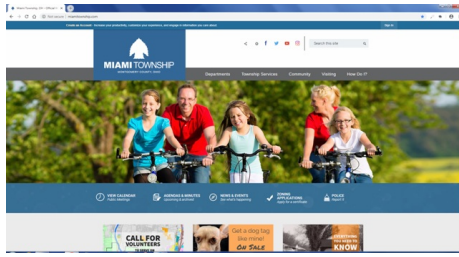

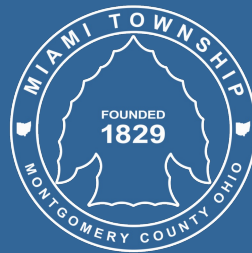
