Miami Township works to use funds in the most efficient and beneficial way to best serve the community. The Board of Trustees recently approved expenditures for much need equipment. Take a closer look at each one:



#### Speed trailers, tasers and drones!

The Miami Township Police Department has many resources available to protect both officers and the community it serves. Wear and tear on equipment is sparking the need for replacement.

The Board of Trustees approved the reallocation of \$175,000 in August to replace old equipment. The funding comes from federal forfeiture money and not taxpayer dollars. Among the purchases the department expects to make:

**Public Works awarded EPA H2O Rivers Grant**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency awarded the Public Works Department a \$33,000 grant to upgrade our wintertime de-icing liquid application. The 2025 H2Ohio Rivers Initiative Chloride Reduction Grant will allow for better application of a more environmentally safe de-icing mixture. The goal is to reduce the amount of chloride that de-icing creates.

A new liquid application system will allow for more precise spraying on the roadways and allow less seepage onto grass and into waterways thus reducing the amount of chloride output. Public Works is responsible for about 92 miles of township roadway.



**SROs head back to school**

Time to head back to school for two of our police officers.

Officer Wolpert is the new School Resource Officer (SRO) at Dayton Christian School. Officer Gates is the new SRO at Miamisburg Middle School.

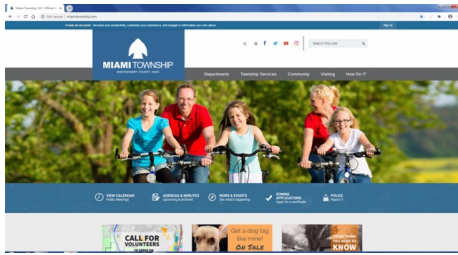
