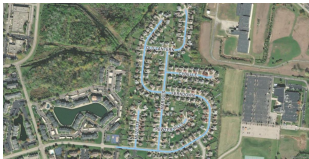
Thank you to everyone that submitted a design. They certainly made the judges' decision difficult.

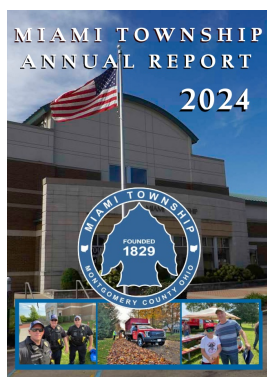
2025 road resurfacing plan

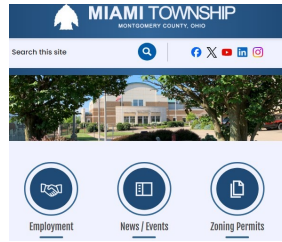

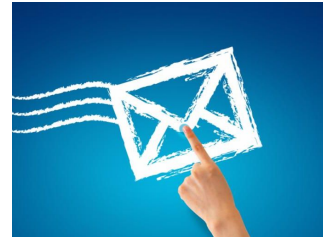
