Electric aggregation rates increase



Miami Township's energy consultant, Trebel Energy, has secured a new electricity supply agreement with Dynegy Energy as part of the township's aggregation program. Under this agreement, participating AES and Duke residents and small businesses will benefit from a fixed electric generation rate of \$0.0917 per kilowatt hour, beginning with their June 2025 meter read, continuing through June 2026.

The program will continue beyond that period, from June 2026 to June 2028, with a flexible pricing structure that reflects capacity costs as they are published each year.

Customers are expected to save money under the aggregation program compared to the new AES and Duke Energy Price to Compare (PTC) rates expected to take effect in June 2025.

It is important to note that residents may opt out of the program at any time and go back to either the standard AES or Duke rate depending upon your address or select an alternative plan through the Energy Choice Ohio program.

A reminder to Rumpke customers that rates will increase June 30, 2025, as the second

extension year takes effect.

The new rate as of June 30 is \$15.85 a month, up from \$15.24. Rental cost for Rumpke trash receptacles remain at \$1.50. Renting these totes is optional.

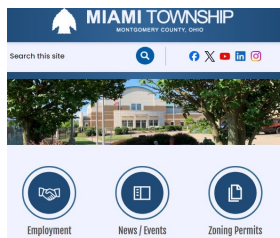

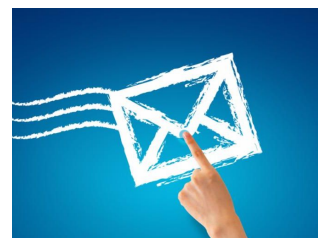
