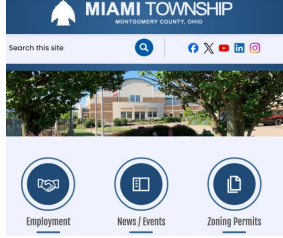


- The Government Center is closed Monday, September 1, for Labor Day. Offices reopen Tuesday, September 2 at 8 a.m. One-day trash delay.
