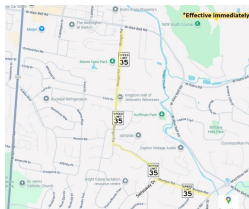

Active Living Workshop

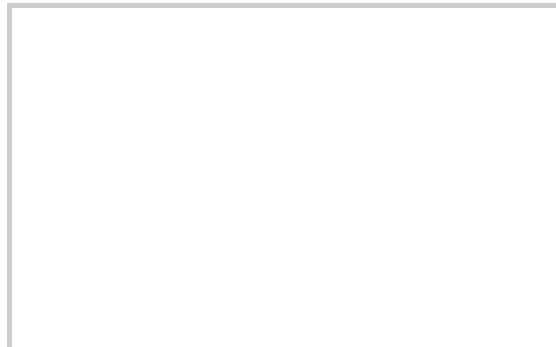
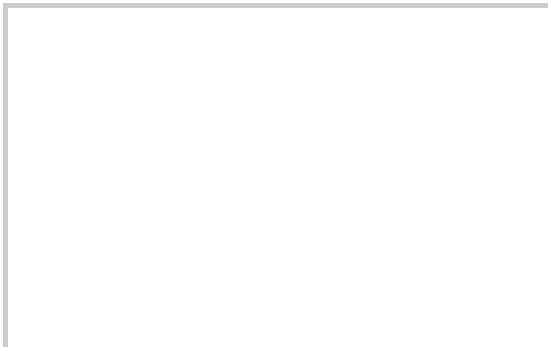
The Community Development Department recently worked with the **Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission**, to conduct an Active Living Workshop.

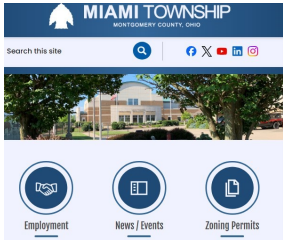

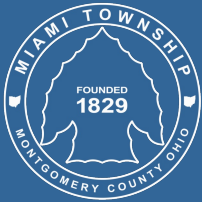
