Miami Township is once again serving as an outpost for purchasing 2026 dog licenses. While the best way to buy tags is **ONLINE**, we are selling them from December 1 through January 31 at the Government Center, 2700 Lyons Road.

The cost this year remains \$20 for a spayed/neutered dog and \$24 for an unaltered dog. **You must have the exact amount if you pay with cash. We cannot make change! We also accept checks, but no credit cards!** Tags may be purchased Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-4 p.m.

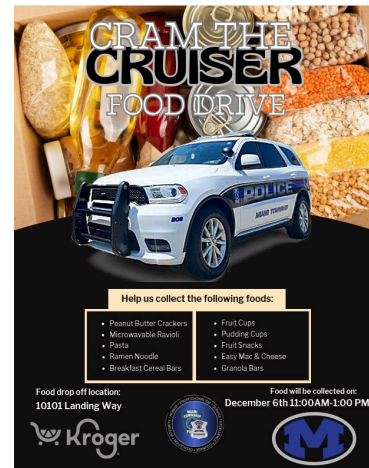
Snowplow Santa coming to Skyline

Memorial Bench Dedicated



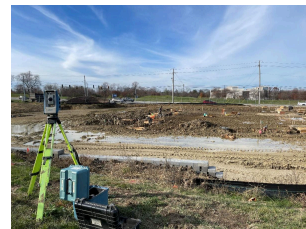

Business Updates

Economic development within Miami Township is booming. You are no doubt seeing a lot of construction underway around the township, many projects which have openings set for 2026. Here is an update:

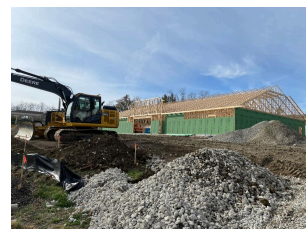
WAWA - Located at 2835 Miami Village Drive, the gas station and convenience store is scheduled to open in June 2026. A company spokesperson says the tanks are being installed and the foundation poured.



Winsupply - Winsupply is expanding its distribution center at 9300 Byers Road. It plans to build another 200,000 sq. ft. building to better serve its customers. Winsupply is a construction wholesaler, supplying products to contractors and installers nationwide.



DG Market - Dollar General Marketplace will offer fresh produce and other grocery items when it opens next year. Construction is underway at its new location at 10259 Byers Road just north of Austin Boulevard.



First Flight Commerce Center - Development at First Flight Commerce Center along Austin Boulevard, east of SR 741, is moving forward quickly. Building 2 at 287,000 square feet, is under construction now.

Accelelevation, who occupies Building 1, is expected to expand into the new building upon completion.



Dayton Mall - Hull Property Group acquired the mall in October. Initial renovation is expected to begin soon. Miami Township is also in the first phase of creating a new Miami Crossing District Master Plan, that will explore future possibilities for the mall and surrounding area.



Dayton Christian School - Dayton Christian School is building a new auxiliary gymnasium on its campus. The new facility will provide student athletes practice and training space in their respective sports. Plans for completion are set for late winter 2026.



Gigi's Place - The assisted living residence is located at 2820 Spring Valley Pike near the intersection of SR 741. It will house 16 residents, each with their own room and bathroom. Construction is well underway. It is scheduled to open in Spring 2026. **CLICK** for a personal message from Gigi's Place Managing Partner Julie Winters.



FJM, Inc. - Fred J. Miller, Incorporated is expanding its manufacturing facility on Washington Church Road. It is adding about 10,000 sq. ft. to its building. FJM, Inc. makes marching band uniforms for high school and college marching bands across the country.

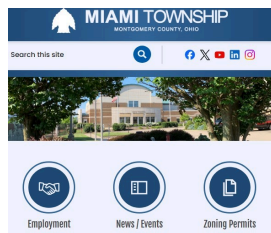

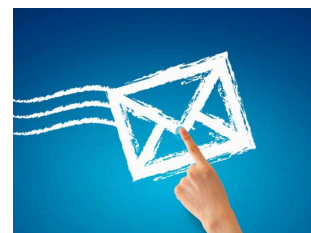

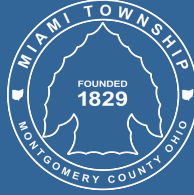
