The role of the Precinct Election Official is crucial in the democratic process. Without them, the polling locations could not be operated.

TO HOLD EACH ELECTION THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS NEEDS YOUR HELP!

As a Precinct Election Official, you are required to:

- Be 18 years old
- A registered voter in Montgomery County
- No felony convictions
- Have transportation to and from the polling location
- Be at assigned polling location at 5:45am-until released by Supervisor after the polls close
- Demonstrate voting procedures to voters
- The ability to deal with the public in a courteous, patient and efficient manner

Precinct Election Officials are paid:

Voting Location Managers: \$130.00 for the day
 Precinct Election Officials: \$120.00 for the day
 Training class: \$25.00
